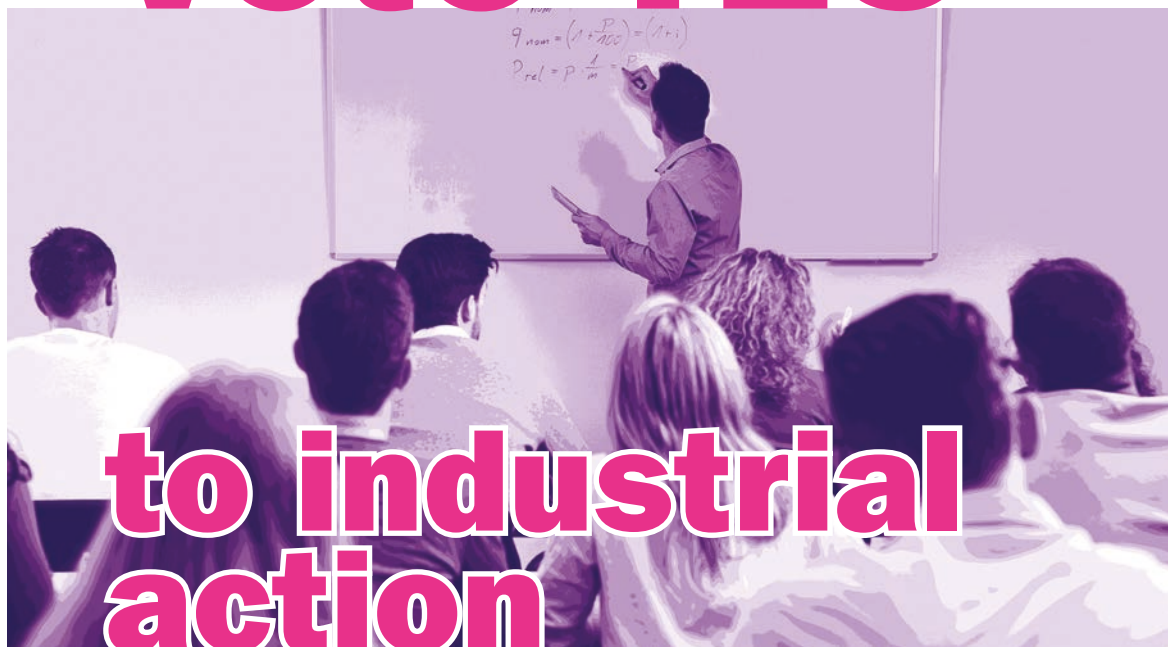

Defend jobs and fight compulsory redundancy at The University of Manchester

Up to 140 academic and academic-related staff in the Faculty of Biology, Medicine and Health, Alliance Manchester Business School, the School of Arts, Languages and Cultures and a number of Professional Support Services areas face the prospect of compulsory redundancy by The University of Manchester.

‘Financial headroom’ has been blamed, but the University remains in a demonstrably strong financial position.

Short term cuts cause long term damage - never before has a university in the UK sacked this number of professors, senior lecturers, lecturers and non-academic staff to create ‘financial headroom’.

This threat is unwarranted and unacceptable.

90 per cent of members voting in the consultative ballot said **YES** to action if the University pressed ahead with these plans
